- June 9- We will have a county practice session from 9:00 AM to Noon at the Cooperative Extension Center to give you feedback.
- June 22- District Activity Day. This is our first competition. Transportation will be provided to Vance County.
- July 21- State Competition. If you place first in your age and division at district activity day, you will go on to compete at the state level in Raleigh.
