Orange County 4-H Receives Grant to Send Teens to National 4-H Healthy Living Summit

Kaitlyn M (Hummingbirds 4-H Club), Olivia C (Hilltoppers 4-H Club), Carmen E (Beyond Expectations 4-H Club), and Camille C (At-Large Member) attended the National 4-H Healthy Living Summit in Chevy Chase, Maryland, February 15-18, 2019.

The conference focused on promoting healthy, sustainable lifestyle choices that included: food allergies, social and emotional health, physical and mental health, healthy advocacy within communities, incorporating healthy living education into special needs programming and opioid prevention.

Participants gained necessary knowledge on methods to improve public health shared by prominent lifestyle and health experts.

Participants also had the opportunity to visit Washington, D.C., and participate in a night tour of the National Monuments.

Their trip was made possible by a generous grant of \$2500 from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation as a special project of the National 4-H Council.

These 4-H members will be working with local partners in the coming months to address health issues in our county through a project of their making,




2019 Orange County 4-H Achievement Night

2019 Orange County Youth Preparedness Camp To Be Held June 24-28. Apply by May 1.

Orange County 4-H will partner with Orange County Emergency Services to host the second annual youth preparedness day camp for students 13 to 18 years of age, June 24-28, 2019. The program is called the North Carolina Youth Preparedness Initiative and is based on a nationally recognized program.

Throughout the week, students will network with leaders in emergency management careers, learn about technology used to help predict natural disasters, learn about preparedness using the national CERT curriculum, and ultimately work with their own family and those around them to develop disaster preparedness plans. Students will also earn certifications in AED and CPR. They will learn to solve problems as a team in a mock disaster simulation.

Interested teens should apply by May 1 at mypinorthcarolina.org. The top twenty-five applicants will be selected and notified by May 10.

The cost to participate will be \$100 which includes all lunches, supplies, and certification costs. Limited support may be available to selected applicants based on financial need.
