Institute for Future Agricultural Leaders (IFAL)- NC Farm Bureau's leadership conference for rising high school seniors. Two conferences take place simultaneously at both NC State University in Raleigh and NC A&T State University in Greensboro the week of June 21 - 26, 2020. Designed for students between 16 and 17 years of age. Students need to be NO YOUNGER than 16 years of age NOR OLDER than 17 years of age as of April 13 of the program year. Extension Community Association (ECA) Scholarship- Each year the state ECA organization as well as Orange County ECA select graduating seniors to receive scholarships to further their education at a college or university. 
