Orange County Provides Virtual "Farm to Table" Platform for 4th Grade Youth

Orange County and Person County have partnered to create an interactive, virtual Farm to Table program for 4th grade students. This work at your own pace virtual program includes topics ranging from agricultural history to dairy. Each content tab comes with a 5-10 minute video, worksheets or other activities such as Kahoots, recipes/nutritional information if applicable, and a quiz that can be copied and administered to check for comprehension. We have done our best to capture footage of local farms and businesses in Orange County to help students see the connections between where they live and the agriculture around them.

Farm To Table is aligned with **4th Grade Essential Standards 4.G.1 and 4.L.2** though you may find that this program supplements other learning objectives.
