



Extension & Community Association Adult and Youth Scholarship Checklist

You can use this checklist as your guide to make sure you have submitted all documents and have the best chances for success.

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Requirements:

- I am currently a high school senior or in college with no break in my formal education OR I am an adult who completed high school, had a break in my education and want to further it now. (Prior scholarship applicants and/or recipients may apply if having no break in formal education.)
 - I live in North Carolina and plan to attend a North Carolina accredited college, community college, or technical institute. Scholarships will be awarded based on financial need (25%), scholarship potential (25%), activities and honors (25%), and Extension and Community Association connection (25%). It is not a requirement to have any connection with either ECA, 4-H or NC Cooperative Extension, but as noted on the application form, 25% of the weight given in each application relates to any connection you might have with any of these organizations.
 - Completed application (download and print from <https://orange.ces.ncsu.edu/wp-content/uploads/2021/01/NCECA-Scholarship-Form.pdf>).
 - Official high school transcript (signed by school official and in a sealed envelope along). If requested my college transcript, it should be mailed to: Ivelisse Colón 4112 Salem Church Rd. Haw River, NC 27258
 - Impact Statement: On a separate page, write a brief paragraph explaining the value or impact ECA, Extension, FCS, and/or 4-H has had on my life and/or my family's life.
 - Three (3) letters of recommendation **signed** by the individuals.
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Application Submission

- All documents have been mailed or delivered in person by 5:00 pm, February 1.
