



Extension & Community Association Adult and Youth Scholarship Checklist

You can use this checklist as your guide to make sure you have submitted all documents and have the best chances for success.

Requirements:

- I am currently a **high school senior or in college** with no break in my formal education **OR** I am **an adult** who completed high school, had a break in my education and want to further it now. (Prior scholarship applicants and/or recipients may apply if having no break in formal education.)
- I live in North Carolina and plan to attend a North Carolina accredited college, community college, or technical institute.
- Completed application (download and print from <https://orange.ces.ncsu.edu/wp-content/uploads/2024/11/NCECA-Scholarship-Form2020.pdf>)
- Official high school **transcript**, signed by school official and in a sealed envelope. If requested my college **transcript**, it should be mailed to: *N.C. Cooperative Extension Attn: Ivelisse Colón Bonnie B. Davis Center 1020 US-70 W. Suite 130 Hillsborough, NC 27278*
- Impact Statement: On a separate page, write a brief paragraph explaining the value or impact Extension & Community Association, NC Cooperative Extension, Family & Consumer Sciences, and/or 4-H has had on my life and/or my family's life.
- Three (3) letters of recommendation signed by the individuals.
- Scholarships will be awarded based on financial need (25%), scholarship potential (25%), activities and honors (25%), and Extension and Community O Association connection (25%). It is not a requirement to have any connection with either ECA, 4-H or NC Cooperative Extension, but as noted on the application form, 25% of the weight given in each application relates to any connection you might have with any of these organizations.

- Mail all documents or delivered by February 3rd, 2025 before 5:00 pm.
